

Neurotune AG is Coordinator of an Eurostars funded Project entitled “Early Diagnosis and Monitoring of Renal Diseases” (Acronym: KIDNEY).

The scope of the project is the validation of a new and most effective diagnostic biomarker (RCAF) for the early monitoring of chronic kidney disease with a possible application in the prognosis of kidney transplant and in acute kidney injury.

KIDNEY Project has a total budget of € 876.560 and a duration of two years.

The project will be conducted in collaboration with academic institutions and with an industry partner. The consortium’s four research teams participating in the KIDNEY Project are: Neurotune (Switzerland); University of Zurich (Switzerland); MicroCoat Biotechnologie (Germany); and Klinikum rechts der Isar der Technischen Universität München (Germany).
